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Dear Parents and Carers,

School Uniform

We have noticed a growing number of children, particularly in the juniors, not wearing the correct school uniform. We believe it is important that the appearance of our children is of a high standard. A school uniform looks smart, contributes to a sense of belonging and community, makes children feel equal to their peers, in terms of appearance, and fosters a feeling of pride.

We expect all children to wear the school uniform as listed below (as published on the school website):

- Navy sweatshirt or cardigan
- Light blue polo shirt
- Grey trousers, or shorts (seasonal)
- Navy skirt/pinafore dress
- Blue chequered summer dress (seasonal, optional)
- Black/Grey or white socks or plain black tights
- Sensible black shoes, that support the feet

PE Kit

- Plimsolls or trainers
- Plain white PE top (polo or t-shirt)
- Shorts-navy
- Plain navy/black jogging bottoms
- School sweatshirt

No obvious branding is allowed. The only exception is the school logo, which is not compulsory. Uniform with the Monks Orchard Primary School logo is available from the school office. Please ask for an order form. Most other items can be bought from any of the major High Street stores. Please make sure that all items of clothing and PE kit are clearly labelled with your child's name.

From next week, all children will be expected to be in correct, full school uniform every day. If your child is not in the correct uniform a reminder letter will be sent home and, from Year 2 upwards, they may receive a short detention on Friday Lunchtime.

If you are finding it hard to make sure your child wears the correct school uniform, please talk to their class teacher.
